Background

In 2023, the Town conducted its first community-wide survey following the adoption of the Town Council's strategic goals, which identified community engagement and actively listening to residents as key priorities. Recognizing that effective local government depends on understanding the needs, expectations, and aspirations of the community, the survey was established as an important tool for gathering meaningful resident feedback and incorporating that input into Town decision-making.

Building on the success of the inaugural survey, the Town intends to conduct the Community Survey on a regular basis, approximately every three years. This schedule provides an opportunity to collect statistically significant feedback, identify emerging trends, measure changes in public perceptions over time, and evaluate progress toward community priorities and strategic objectives.

The 2026 edition of the Community Survey is no exception. The information gathered provides valuable insight into resident satisfaction, community priorities, and future needs, helping the Mayor, Town Council, and staff align Town resources with the issues that matter most to the community. This information will directly inform the 2027 Budget Process for the Town.

Methodology

Data Collection

The 2026 Community Engagement Survey was open to all residents of Parachute Proper, Battlement Mesa, and the surrounding area. It was open to responses from July 1st to July 26th, 2026. Surveys were available online through SurveyMonkey and in-person at Town Hall. Both online and paper surveys were available in English and Spanish. The survey was sent out via email and text, and links to the survey were posted on the Town of Parachute website and social media channels.

Respondents were instructed to fill out the survey once per person and the online survey was restricted to only allow a single submission per device. The survey informed that all responses would be kept confidential, but respondents were given the option to enter their names and contact information to be entered into a raffle. Survey responses would be considered separately from their identities to ensure confidentiality.

Overall, the survey received 418 responses, 295 of which completed the entire survey. 385 responses were collected via text or email, 32 were collected via the Parachute website, and one was collected in person. 404 of these responses were collected in English, and 14 were collected in Spanish.

This survey has a confidence level above 95% with a 4.65% margin of error. This means the survey results have a less than 5% chance of being invalid, and true public opinion is within 4.65% of the survey's results. This is within the guidelines to be considered a statistically representative sample of the population. The survey received 93 responses from residents of Parachute proper. The Parachute proper responses have an 85% confidence level with a margin of error of 7.25%. These responses are not exact enough to be considered statistically representative of the population within the Town of Parachute proper, but they can still be a useful guideline in determining town strengths, weaknesses, and priorities.

This survey was available to the public and did not target specific demographic groups like the 2023 survey did. This means the 2026 survey will be less statistically representative of certain populations who responded in lower numbers. Demographic Information

Survey respondents were asked to answer several demographic information questions to give us a better sense of who was responding. 34% of respondents indicated they live in Parachute Proper, with the rest living in Battlement Mesa or the surrounding community. 66% of respondents were women, 30% were men, and 4% identified as other or chose not to say. 82% of respondents identified as White. 11% of respondents identified as being of Hispanic, Latino/a/x, or Spanish origin. 15% of respondents were age 18-34, 41% were 35-54, and 44% were 55 or older. No one under the age of 18 completed the survey, despite it being made available.

The 2023 survey did not differentiate between responses from Parachute Proper and the broader community. In 2023, 41% of respondents were women and 59% were men. The disparity between 2023 and 2026 responses can likely be explained by the change from targeted responses to an open survey since response rates for open surveys are frequently higher among women than men. 88% of respondents identified as White and 13% identified as being of Hispanic, Latino/a/x, or



Spanish origin. These numbers are comparable to this year's results. 37% of respondents were age 18-34, 36% of respondents were 35-54, and 27% were 55 or older. These differences are likely also due to the method change, as older people are consistently more likely than younger people to respond to open surveys.

Analyzing the Data

These results were analyzed by score averages and percent positives. Score averages assign a score to each rating on the Likert scale and calculate an average score based on the ratings. Rating scales varied slightly by section, but were generally based on a 1-4 scale, with a "poor" rating equaling a one, a "fair" rating equaling a two, a "great" rating equaling a three, and an "excellent" rating equaling a four. The weighted averages of these ratings were then calculated to find the average score. As was done in 2023, the "don't know" responses were removed from the analyses.

Each question's percent positive was also calculated. This number represents the percentage of respondents that selected a positive response. "Excellent", "great", and "fair" were all categorized as positive responses, and "poor" was categorized as a negative response. For questions with ratings of "very likely," "likely," "unlikely," and "very unlikely," only the responses of "very likely," and "likely," were included as positive responses.

These statistics were calculated for both the 2023 and 2026 Community Engagement Survey results to compare. Columns were created showing both the category averages and the percent positives for both years, and the net differences between years were calculated in the "net change" columns.

The responses from community members who indicated they were from Parachute Proper were isolated and analyzed independently. These responses were included in both sets of data. Parachute Proper responses were not compared against 2023 results due to a lack of data.

Key Findings

Quality of Life and Likelihood of Staying in Parachute Improved Over 2023

Average quality of life metrics rose slightly from 2023, with the most noticeable improvements in Parachute's quality as a place to work and raise children. Respondents also rated the quality of their individual neighborhoods very positively, with positive ratings increasing from 86% to 95% and the average score rising from 2.51 to 2.81. Overall, positive ratings of the quality of life in Parachute rose 8% in 2026, and ratings of Parachute as a place to live increased from 92% positive (2.33 avg.) in 2023 to 94% positive (2.62 avg.) in 2026.

Parachute as a place to work received one of the lowest ratings in the quality of life category, with only a 56% positive rating (1.83 avg.). However, this was a significant 13% increase from scores received in 2023. Parachute as a place to raise children received a 90% positive (2.54 avg.) rating and Parachute as a place to retire received a 85% positive (2.63 avg.) rating. Both were increases over 2023 at 7% and 3% collectively.

Residents also report that they are likely to stay in Parachute and recommend it to someone who asks. Residents planning to stay in the community for the next five years rose from 70% in 2023 to 73%, and residents who would recommend Parachute as a place to live rose from 60% to 65%.

Residents Feel Safer than Ever

Feelings of safety in Parachute and the surrounding community, which were already high in 2023, have risen significantly. Feelings of safety in Parachute's downtown commercial district rose 17%, safety from property crime rose 20%, safety from violent crime rose 18%, and other areas experienced similar improvement. The only safety metric that did not increase was the feeling of safety from fires, floods, and other natural disasters, which decreased 5%. However, the overall feeling of safety in Parachute jumped an incredible 32% with an overall 90% positive (3.13 avg.) rating in 2026 compared to just a 58% positive (2.5 avg.) rating for the same question in 2023. The overall category for safety ratings were 83% positive, which is a 14% improvement from 2023.

In the public safety services section, residents report improvements in fire services, ambulance services, emergency preparedness, crime prevention, and more. However, animal control ratings declined significantly, with the average score dipping from 1.88 to 1.61 and positive ratings decreasing by 21%. This is not surprising due to the Town of Parachute and surrounding areas not having any formal animal control program in place. The lower score in animal control was balanced out by the positive scores in all the other areas, and overall positive public safety service ratings were 1% higher in 2026.

Economy and Cost of Living Concerns Persist

Survey respondents had mixed results about Parachute's economy in 2026. While community members reported minor improvements in the quality of business and service establishments, they had concerns about the overall economic health of the Town, and several categories had minor to moderate decreases. Despite the concerns, the economic category's rating didn't change too much, with the percent positive only dropping 2% compared to responses in 2023.

Affordability and basic needs ratings also saw mixed results. Ratings of affordable quality housing rose 15%, and the average score rose from 1.55 to 1.74. There were also improvements in accessibility of affordable quality healthcare, childcare and preschool, and preventive health services. However, residents rated the availability of affordable quality food 4% lower. Overall basic needs ratings increased by 5% in 2026, with the improvement of affordable quality housing being a significant part of that boost.

Residents Seeing Stronger Community, Diversity, and Citizen Engagement

Residents had strong positive feelings about the Town's progress in developing the community. Several areas saw major increases in positive ratings and average scores. Rating for opportunities to attend cultural/arts/music activities increased 12% with a 0.17 point increase, community support for the arts improved 14% with a 0.23 point increase, and sense of civic/community pride increased 23%, with average scores rising from 1.88 to 2.24. The overall category saw a 7% improvement from 2023, and average scores rose from 2.04 to 2.15.

Citizen engagement was measured by asking residents whether they had taken certain actions to engage with their community within the last 12 months. 31% of respondents indicated that they had attended a local public meeting within the last year, 38% indicated they volunteered within the community, and 23% indicated that they had campaigned or advocated for a local issue, cause, or candidate. These statistics are significantly higher than in 2023. However, carpooling rates decreased 4% and rates of respondents opting to walk or bike instead of driving decreased 9%. Despite these decreases, the category results remained generally positive, with engagement seeing a 5% increase from 2023.

Residents also indicated that Parachute's welcoming of diversity had improved since 2023, with 12% increases in Parachute's ability to attract people from diverse backgrounds and value/respect those residents. The Town also saw a 10% increase regarding its care for vulnerable residents, like seniors, disabled people, and homeless people. The category saw an 11% boost in positive ratings, with average ratings going from 2.27 to 2.38.

Utilities, Transportation, and General Services

Residents noted moderate improvements to utility services across Parachute. Affordable high-speed internet ratings improved 10% and average scores increased from 1.94 to 2.28, and recycling rates improved by 14%, with average scores going from 1.53 to 1.72. Residents rated

power utilities 5% lower and indicated little or no change in sewer services and garbage collection. Overall utility ratings were 4% higher than the 2023 responses.

General services and street maintenance ratings remained relatively consistent from 2023.

Notable changes include a 12% increase in favorable health services scores and a 16% increase in street repair. Street maintenance improved 3% and general Town services kept its rating from 2023 and very positive scores of 96% for the overall customer service by Parachute employees.

Community members noted concerns about transportation in Parachute, with several ease of travel scores decreasing. Traffic flow ratings dropped 11% and the average score dropped from 2.73 to 2.3. Overall, transportation ratings dipped 3% and the average score lowered from 2.7 to 2.52 and satisfaction with Bus or Transit Service in the region also decreased 6 percentage points from 2023 with the average rating going from 2.69 to 2.36.

Trust in Town Government and the Town's Integrity Grew

Respondents indicated moderate improvements in the Town of Parachute government's sense of integrity and trustworthiness. They noted an increase in Parachute's job of informing residents about issues facing the community, treating residents with respect, welcoming resident involvement, generally acting in the best interest of the community, and more. Overall, positive response rates regarding government integrity rose by 6%. This was primarily driven by the strong ratings given to the Town for "being honest" (84% and 5% increase), "being open and transparent to the public" (82% and 6% increase), "treating all residents with respect" (86% and 8% increase), and "generally acting in the best interests of the community" (85% and 8% increase).

Overall, respondents also rated the Town government much more favorably compared to the state and federal levels of government. 84% of respondents were positive when rating the performance of the Town and gave an average rating of 2.49. That is much higher than the State of Colorado (56% positive and 1.84 average) and Federal Government (56% positive and 1.78 average).

Important Issues Remain Consistent Moving Forward

Respondents were asked to indicate how important it is for the Parachute community to focus on certain issues over the next two years. Residents ranked the four most important policy areas to be safety, infrastructure, economics, and health and wellness opportunities. The safety and economic ratings are the same as 2023, but the importance of infrastructure and health and wellness opportunities both rose by 7%.

- **Safety:** 87%
- **Economics:** 85%
- **Infrastructure:** 86%
- **Health & Wellness:** 80%

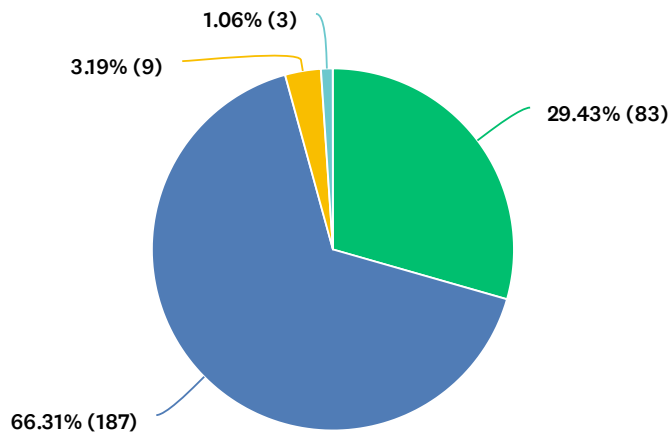
How long have you lived in the community?

What is your gender?



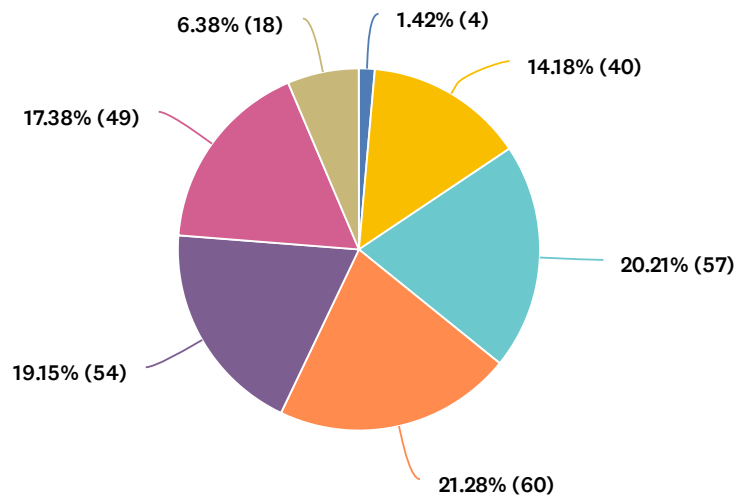

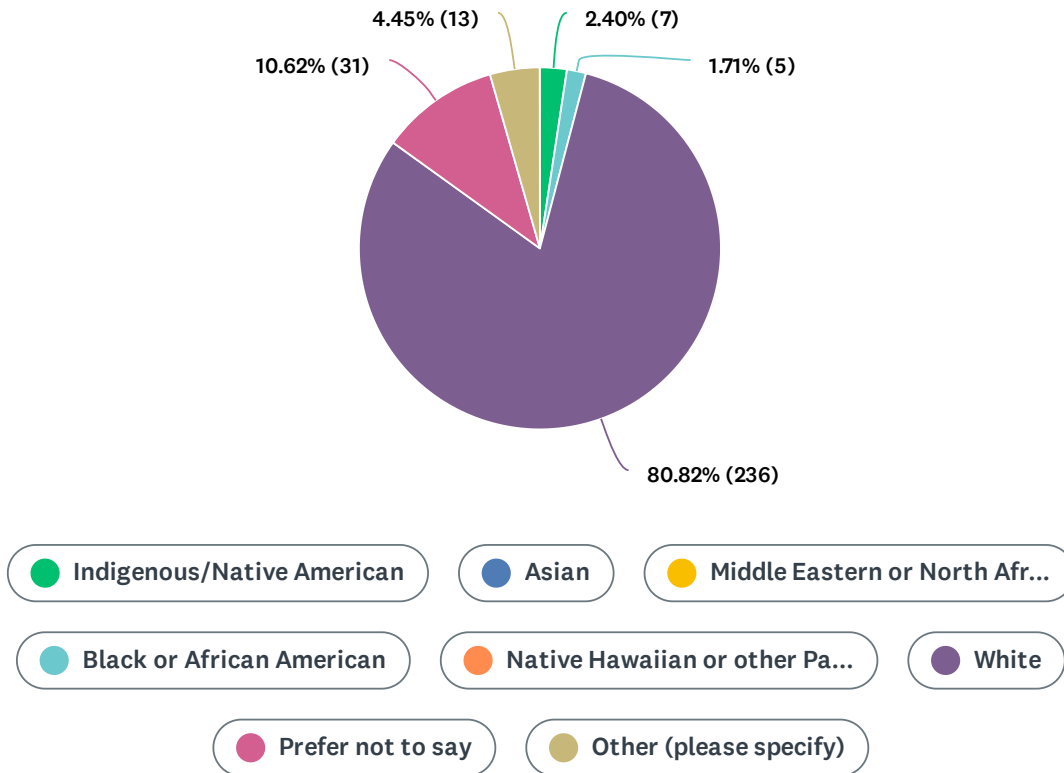
What is your age?

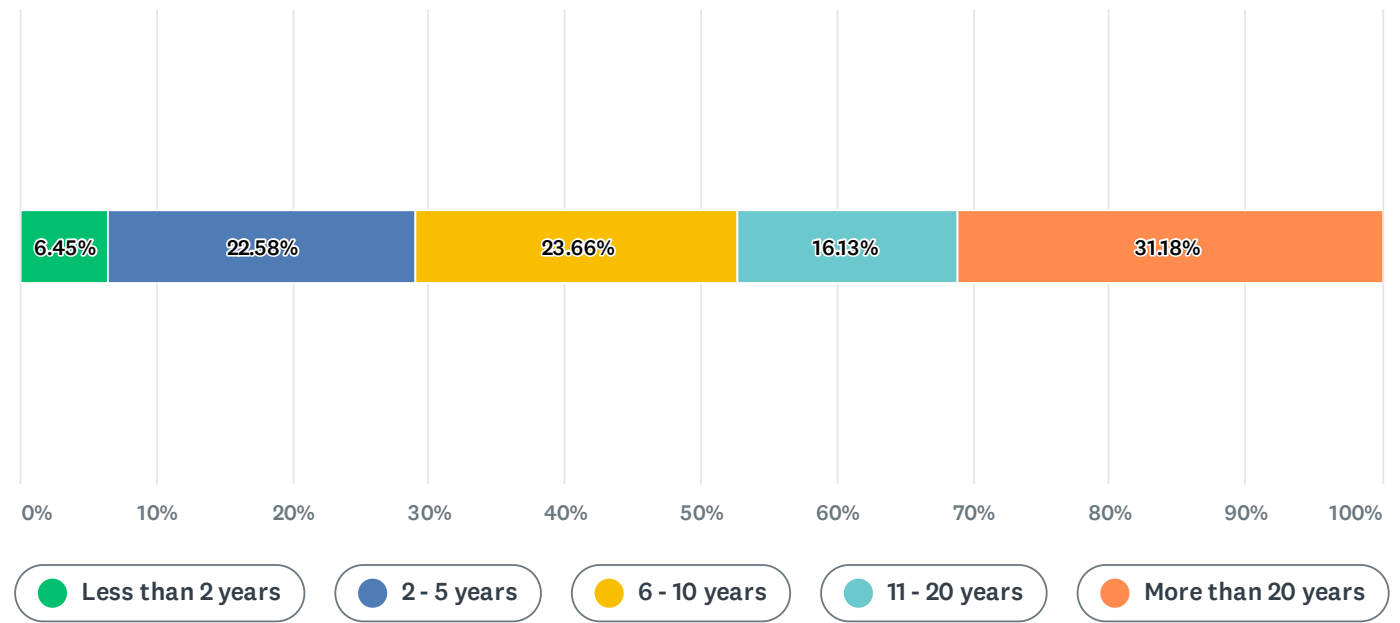

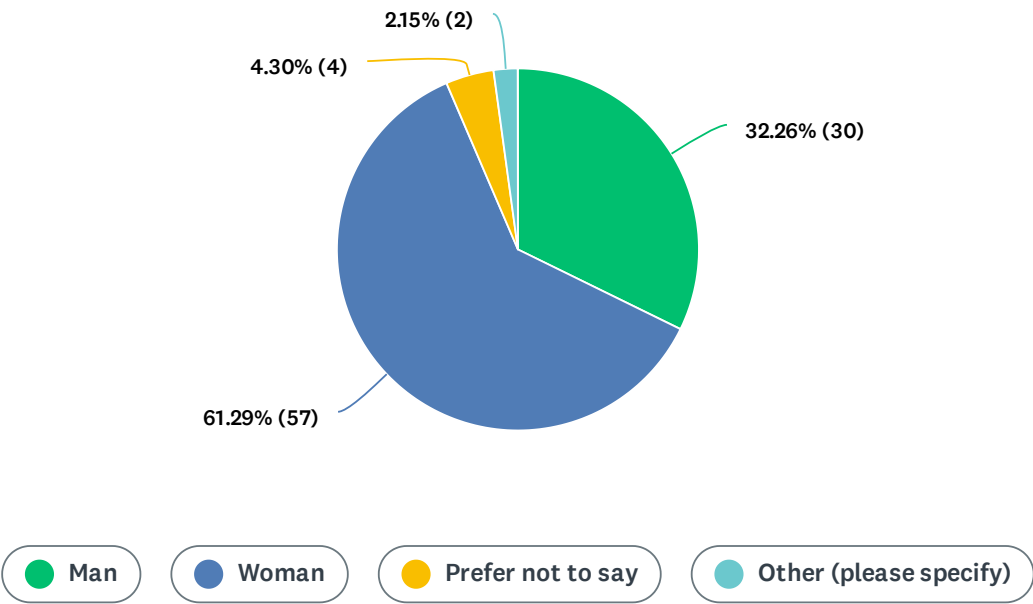
How long have you lived in the community?

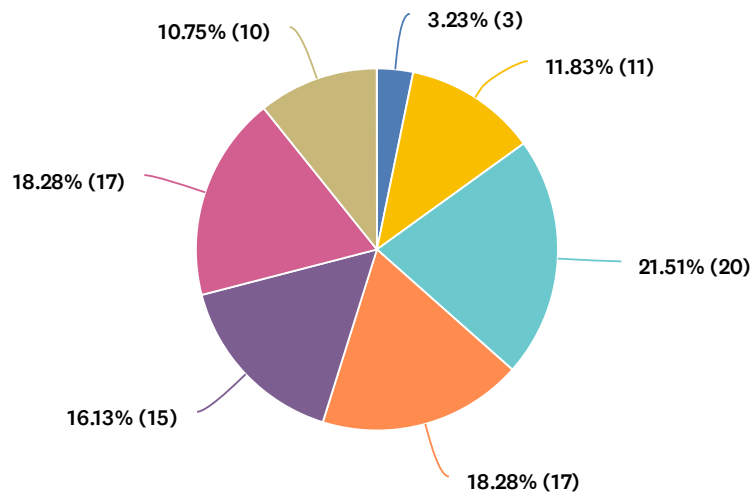
What is your gender?

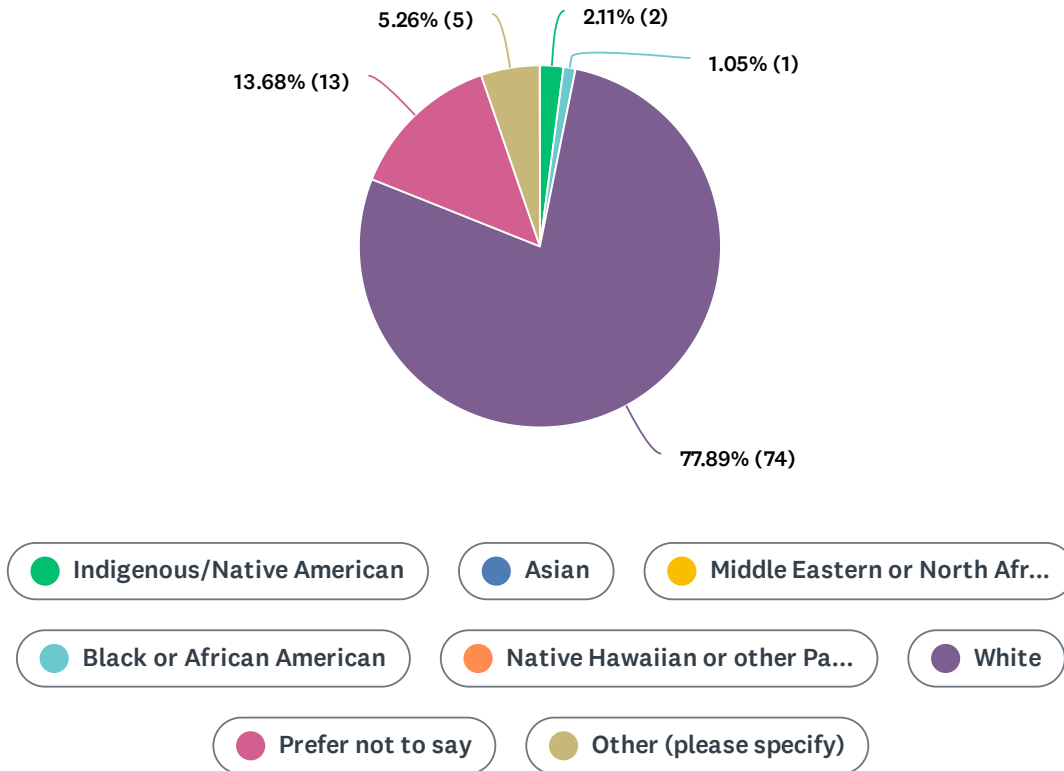
What is your age?

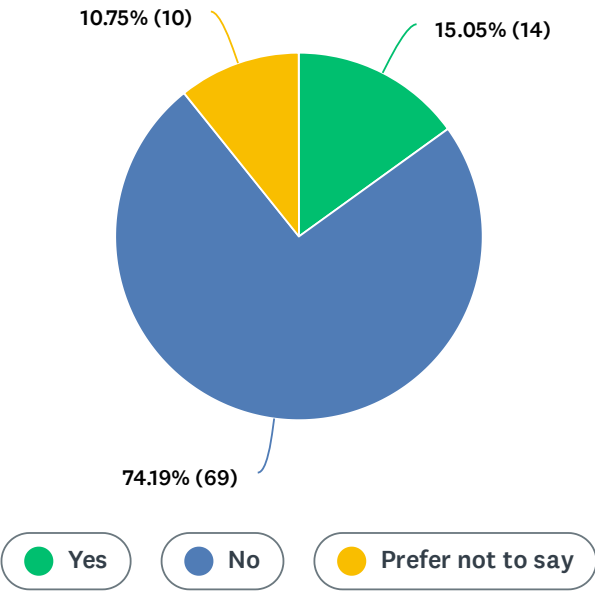

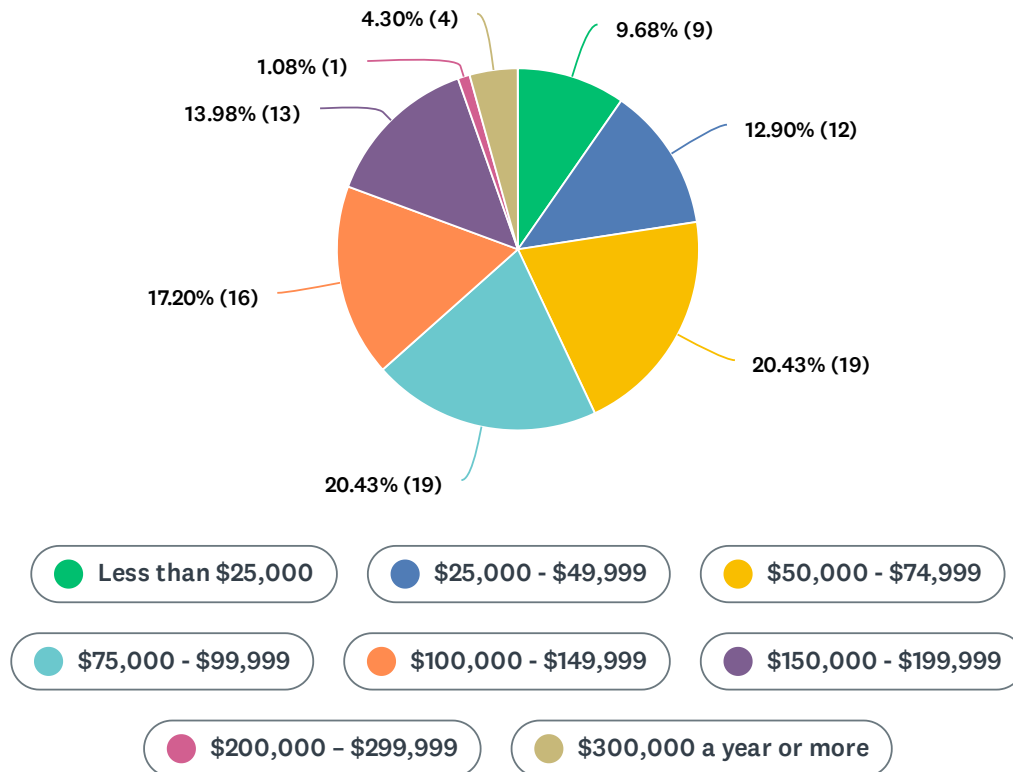
Are you of Hispanic, Latino/a/x, or Spanish origin?

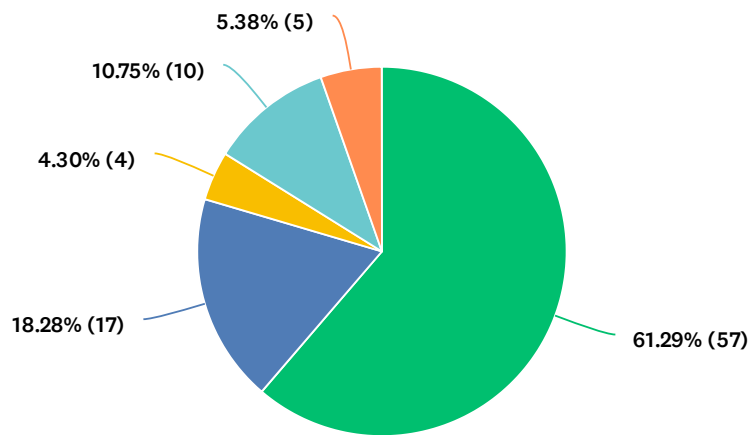

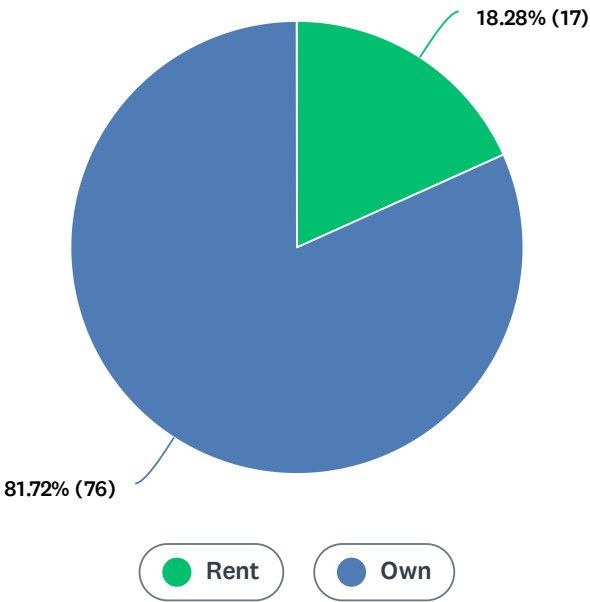

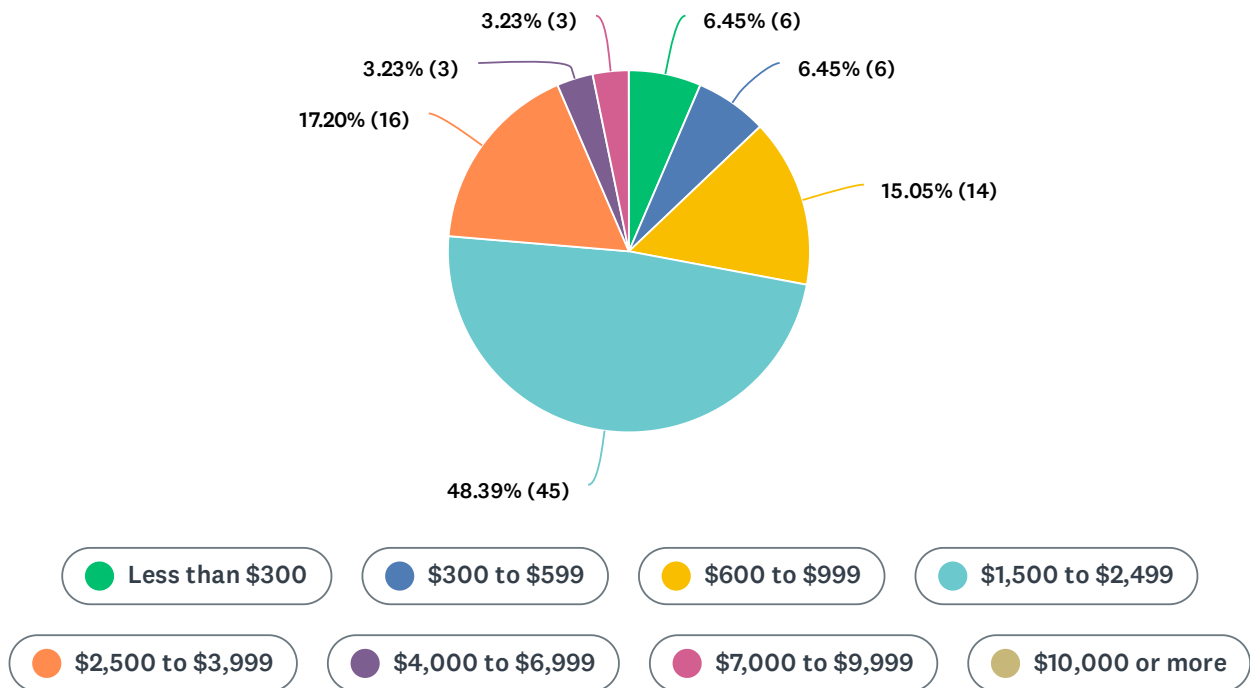
Do you rent or own your home?

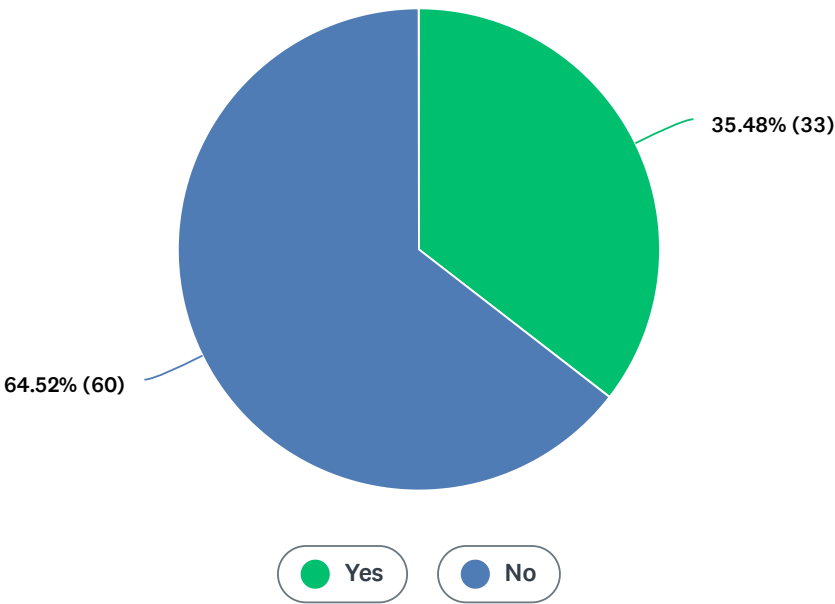

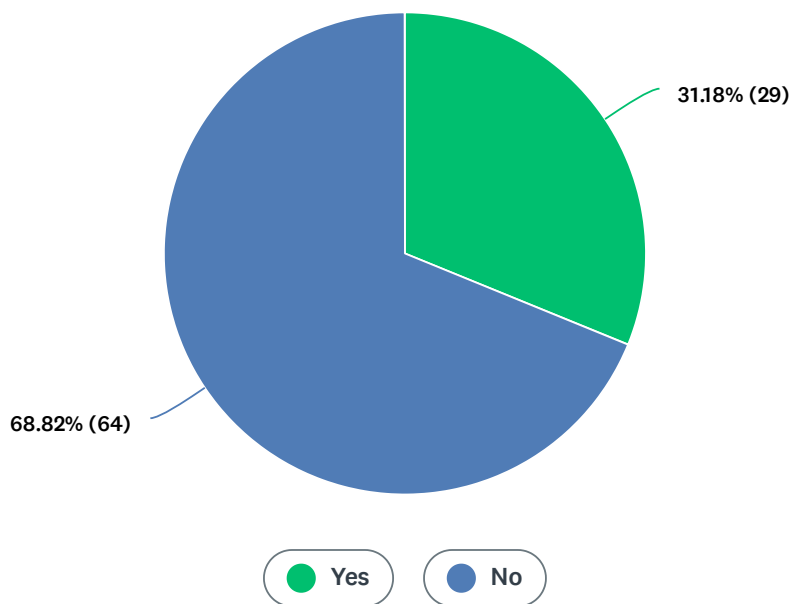

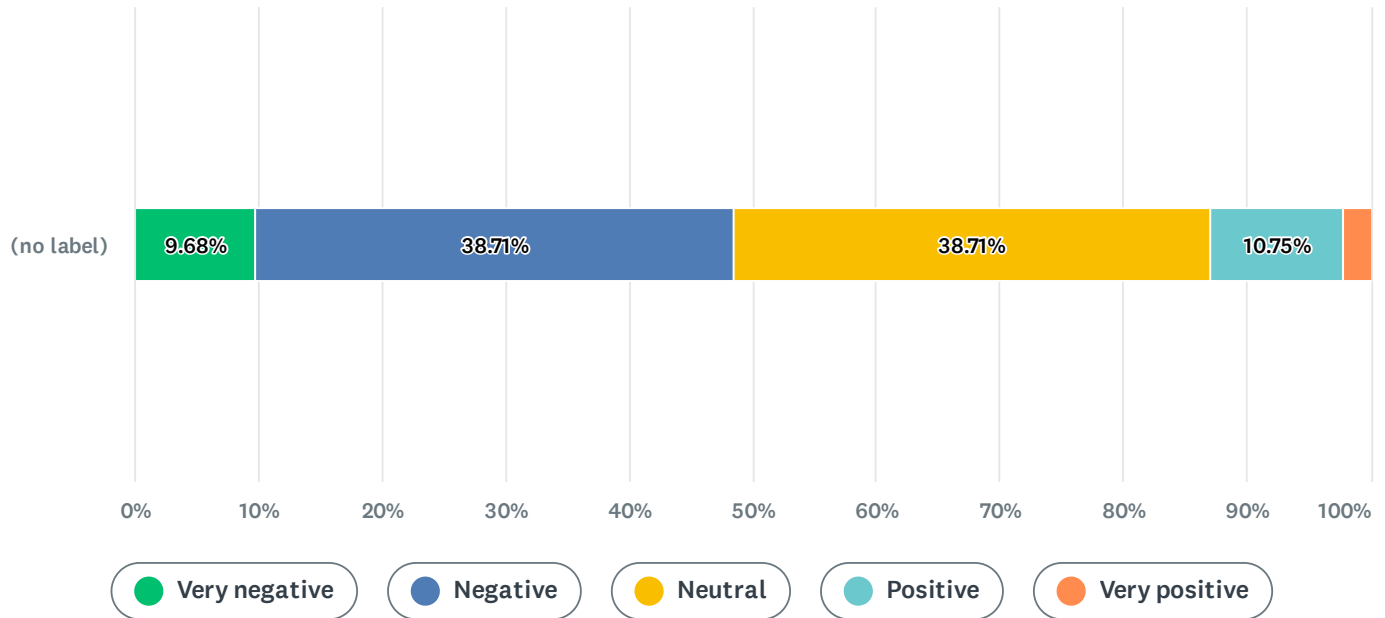
Are you or any other members of your household aged 65 or older?

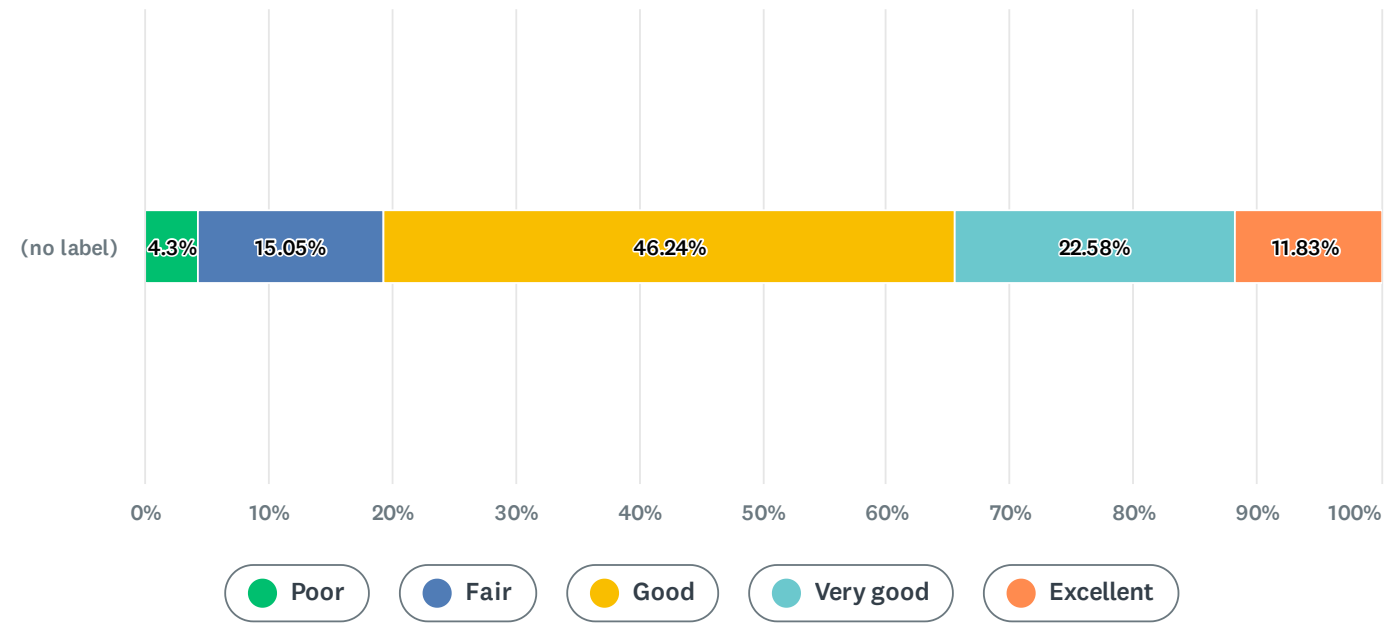
